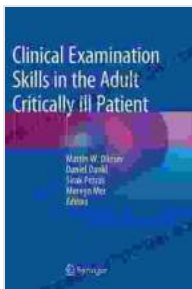

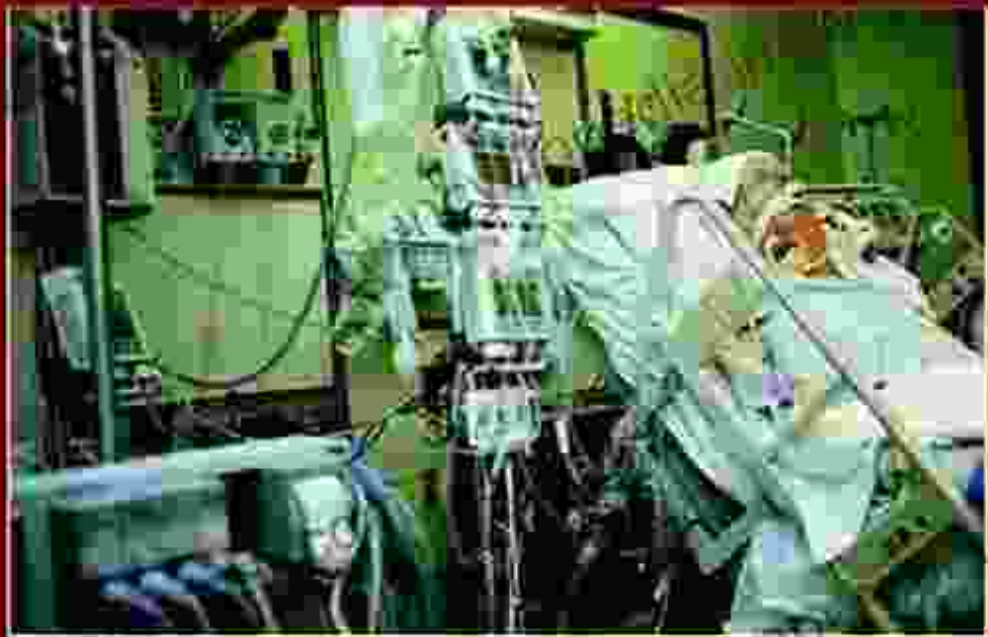

Table 47.1 AVPU – the patient's response

A	Eyes are fully open if they react to the name & voice. The patient is oriented to time and place and usually mobile.
V	Eyes may not be open but the patient does not always give obvious answers to questions. Do you know where you are?
P	Eyes may or may not be open but there is no response to the question. Does your name mean anything? Do you know where you are?
U	Unconscious. There is no response to speech. Do you know where you are?

Figure 47.2 Face, arm, speech, time (FAST) test for stroke

Face	Does the patient's face droop on one side? Can the patient smile?
Arm	Can the patient raise both arms and keep them there?
Speech	Is the patient's speech slurred?
Time	Is the patient's level of consciousness normal? Is the patient's level of consciousness normal?

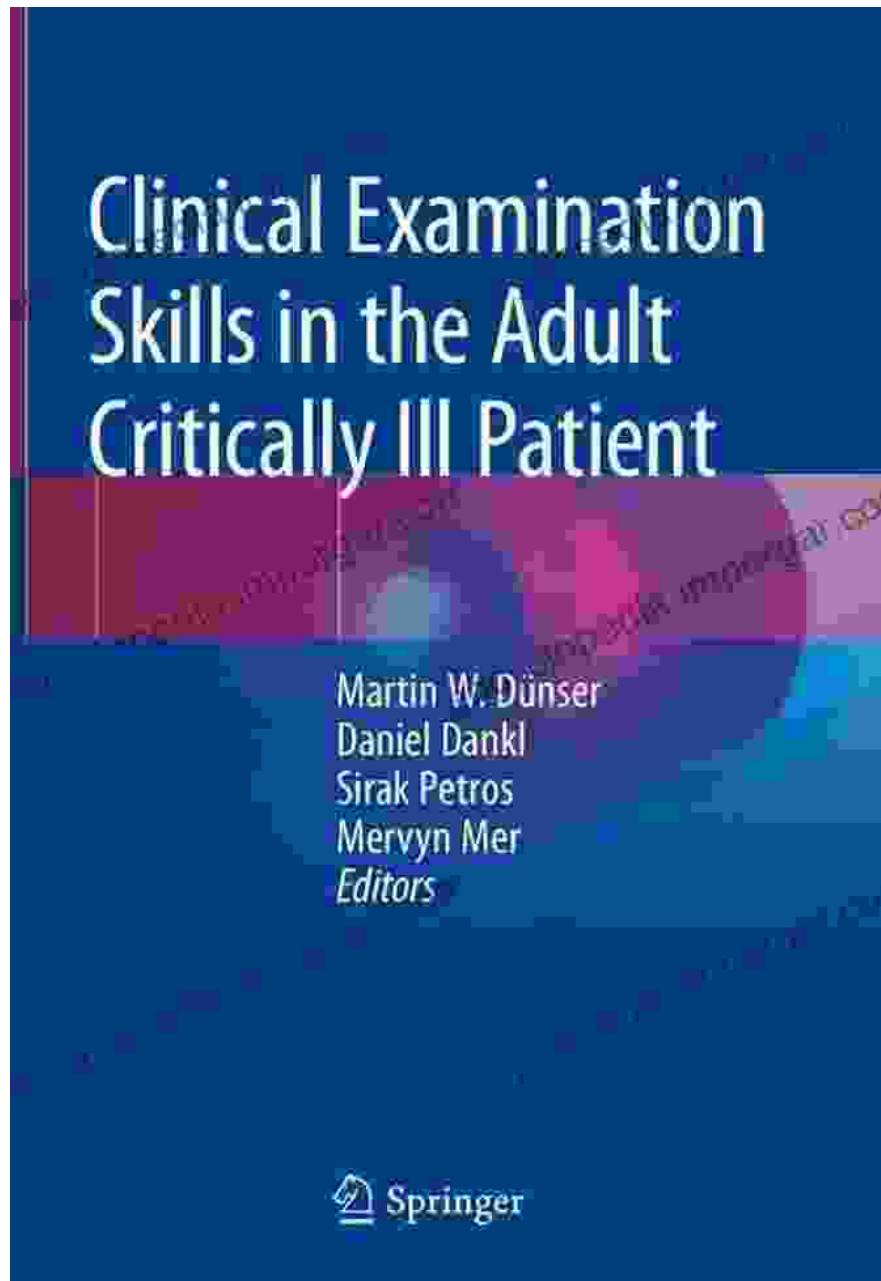

	5. C6-C7	Arm adduction	Arm abduction
	6. C7-C8	Arm flexion	Arm extension
Lumbar	7. L1-L2	Toe flexion	Toe extension
	8. L2-L3	Toe extension	Toe flexion
	9. L3-L4	Toe flexion	Toe extension
