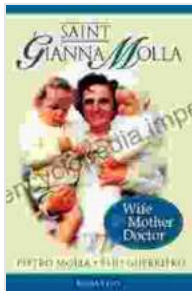


Saint Gianna Molla: Wife, Mother, Doctor, and Servant of God

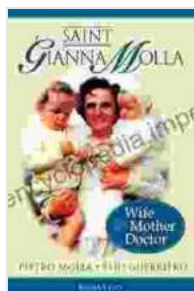

I ask for your special intercession for unborn children. Help them to be born into a world that is filled with love and compassion. Help them to grow up to be healthy and happy children.

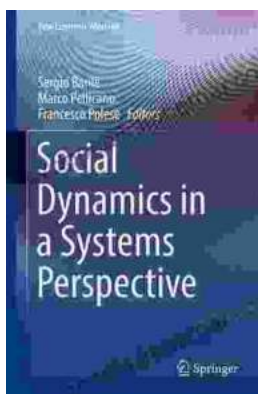

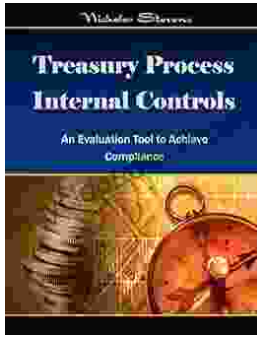
