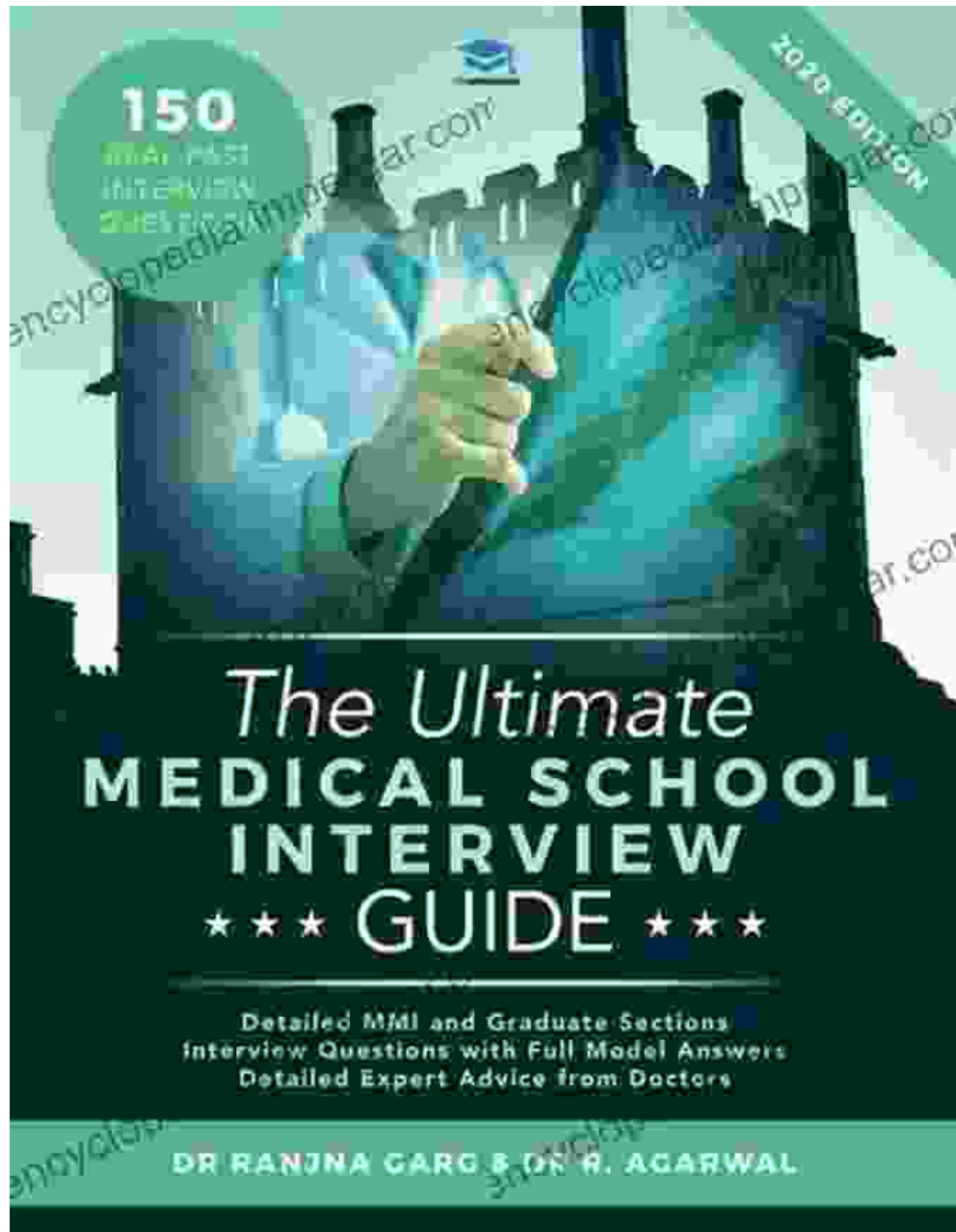
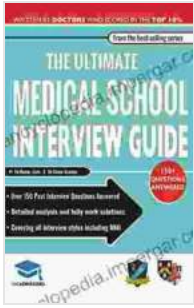

graduates?

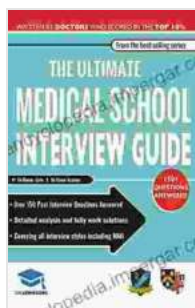
Follow Up

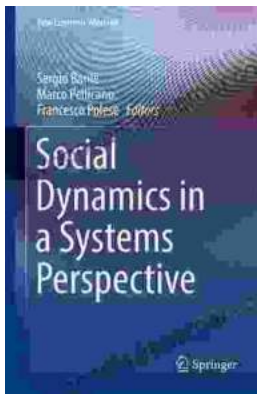

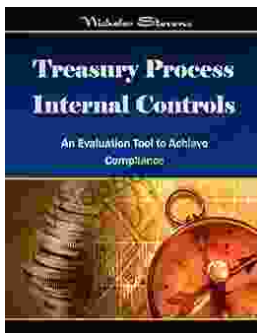
