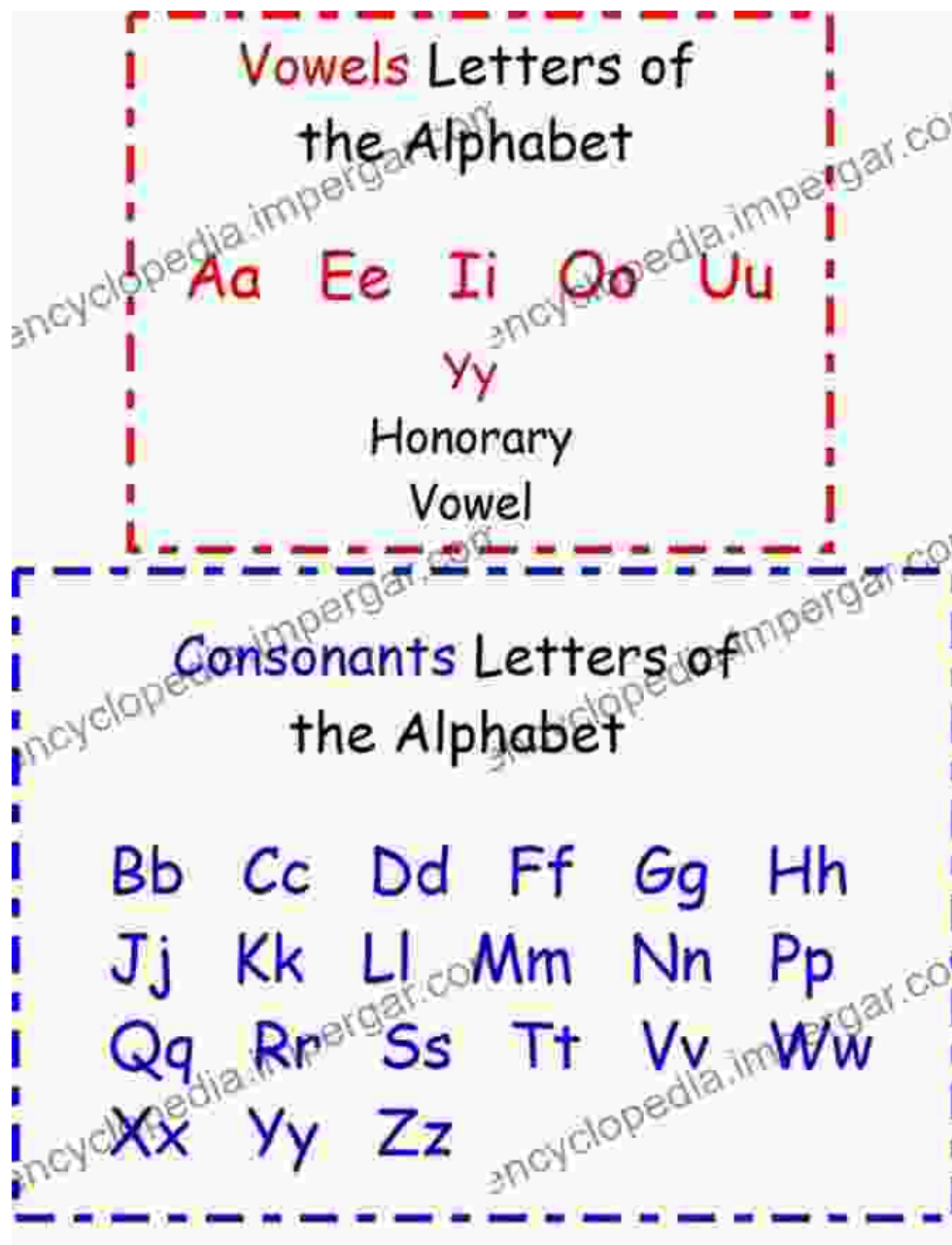

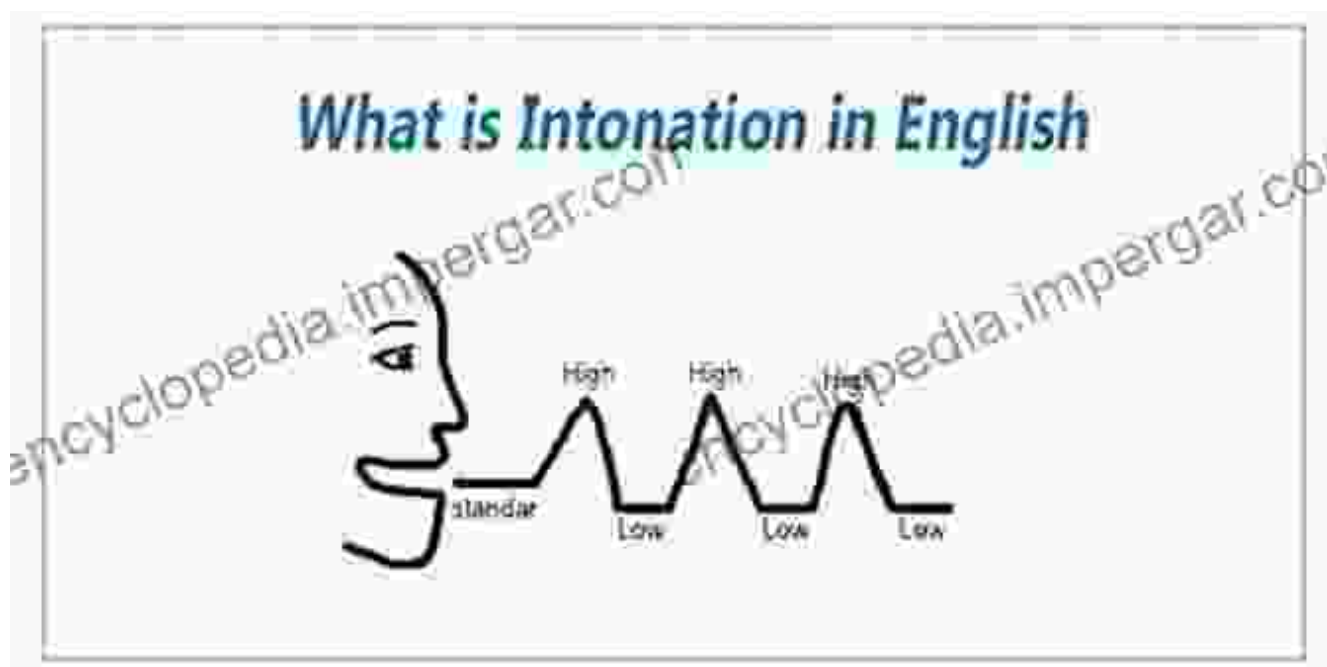

Denasalization	A nasal sound (m, n, ng) is replaced with a non-nasal sound (b, d, g)	"dow" for "now"	2.5 yrs
Assimilation	One consonant starts to sound like another in the word	"pop" for "hop"	3 yrs
Final Consonant Devoicing	A voiced consonant at the end of the word (b, d, g) is replaced with a non-voiced sound (p, t, k)	"leck" for "leg"	3 yrs
Reduplication	The repetition of a syllable in a word	"wawa" for "water"	3 yrs
Coalescence	Two sounds are replaced with one sound that has similar features	"fider" for "spider"	6 yrs
Pre-vocalic Voicing	A voiceless sound (p, f, k) at the start of the word is replaced with a voiced sound (b, v, g)	"game" for "came"	6 yrs

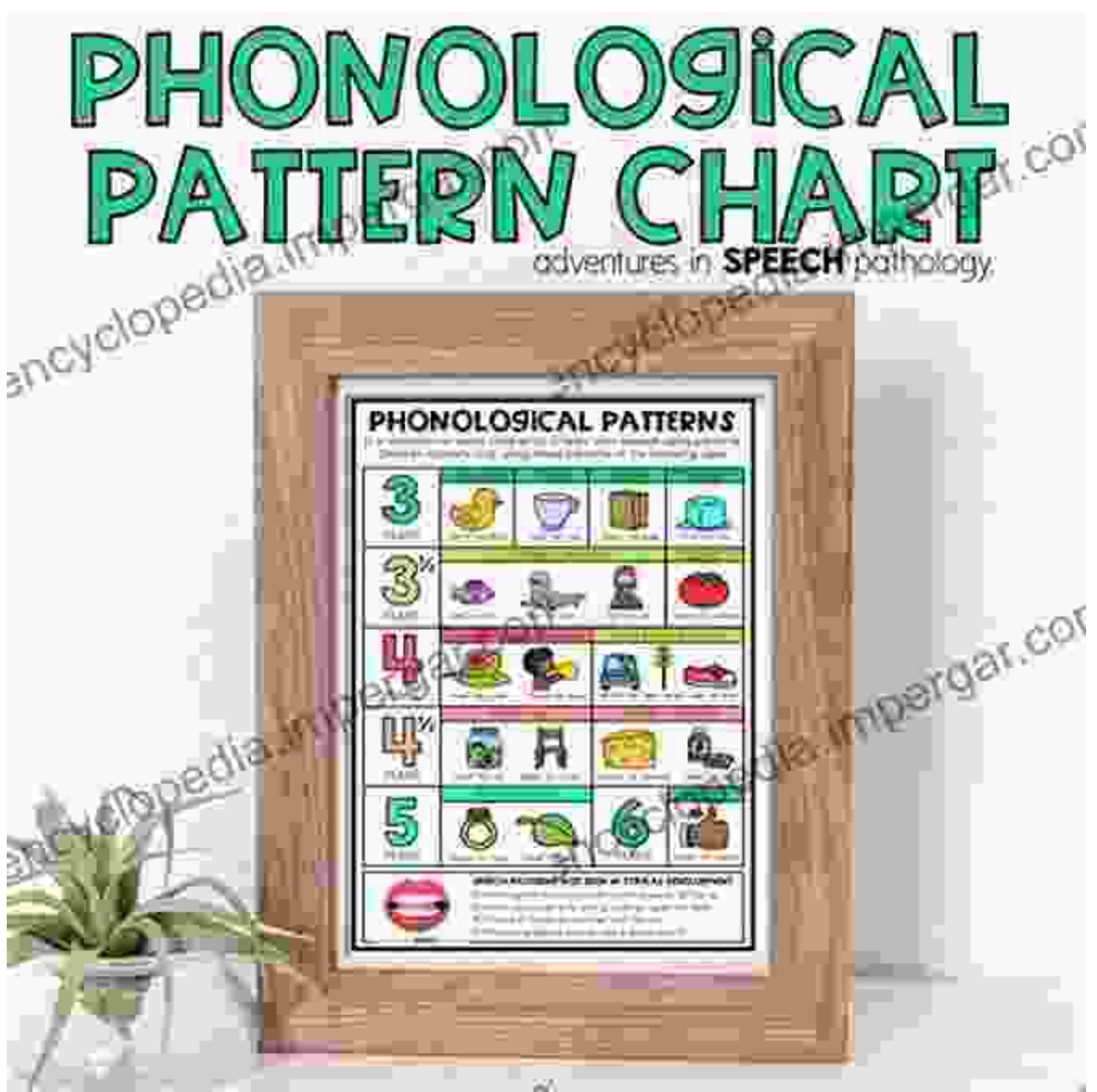

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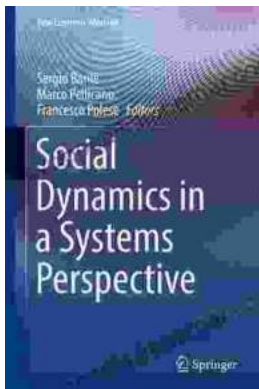
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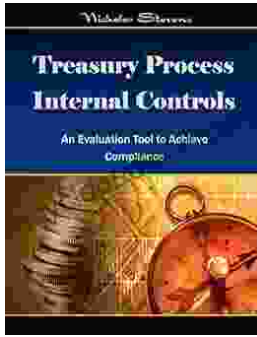
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
